Repair to cattle grid at Long Green – A new cattle grid and adjoining gate have been installed.	Resolved

Polling stations – An update was requested from Councillor Good regarding the review of polling stations for Marske and New Forest which is currently Scriddlehurst Cottage. At a Full Council Meeting held on the 22nd Oct it was decided to merge Marske and Marrick and in future use Marrick Village Hall as the Polling station for both Parishes. It is not thought the change will effect the General Election on 12th Dec.
